<p>Coyote acting bold, aggressively or exhibiting uncharacteristic behaviors. Examples:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Pets or humans being approached or followed; coyote falling over, injured. Coyote closely blocking your path; lunging at pet or human. Coyote present on property day and night and returning regularly; growling. Coyote attacks/kills pets or livestock. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Verify the incident Send communication to the residents Removal of coyote Communication to the Division of Wildlife 	<p>Residents</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Report incident to the police department by calling (330) 342-1800. (In the event of a medical emergency, please call 911). <p>City</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Appropriate staff member discusses with resident to verify and document the event Determine best method for communicating necessary messaging to residents Notify county Wildlife Officer of the incident <p>Division of Wildlife</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Communicate incident to district wildlife management staff and discuss trapping/removal services
<p>Physical human encounter. Example: Seemingly intentional attack on a human being.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Verify incident Send communication to the residents Removal of coyote Communication to the Division of Wildlife 	<p>Residents</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Report incident to the police department by calling (330) 342-1800. (In the event of a medical emergency, please call 911). <p>City</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Dispatch appropriate staff to investigate the claim Determine best method for communicating necessary messaging When able to do so, lethally remove the coyote. If needed, request assistance from the Division of Wildlife Notify county Wildlife Officer of the incident <p>Division of Wildlife</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Assist with lethal removal of the coyote if requested Communicate incident to district wildlife management staff
